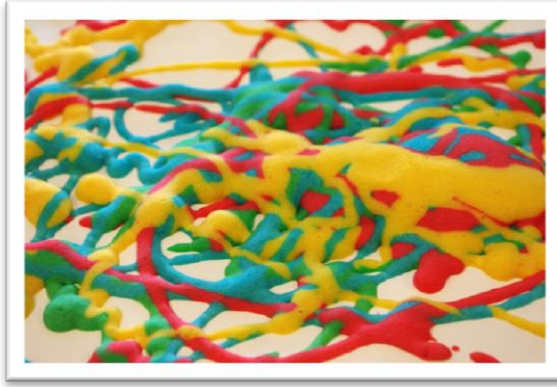


Microwave Puffy Paint

Start with one cup of flour and mix in 3 teaspoons of baking powder, 1 teaspoon of salt and enough water to make it the consistency of pancake batter. Divide the mix into four parts and put them into snack size Ziploc clear plastic bags along with some food colouring. Part of the fun is squishing it all around to mix up the colours!



Tie a rubber band on the top of the bags, like you would if you were icing a cake. Cut off a small corner of the bag.

Start painting! When you're finished, put the painting into the microwave for 30-45 seconds and watch the paint puff up and grow – such fun! The great thing is that it's completely dry when you take it out of the microwave so there aren't any messes left behind!
